Grant Criteria	
Innovation and Creativity	Innovative projects in teaching and learning that are beyond the scope of the regular school budget.
Project Goals and Objectives	Clearly worded and aligns with state, district and school goals and standards.
Leadership and Citizenship	Encourages leadership and good citizenship in students and teachers.
Impact on Students	Project impacts a significant number of students within a building, grade, department, or individual classroom.
Collaboration	Encourages collaboration between educational professionals cross-grade and cross-district and/or parents, businesses, or community organizations to benefit the schools of the Tantasqua Regional/Union 61 District.
Assessment	Includes specific and detailed methods for assessing the educational outcomes of the project including a pre-evaluation where appropriate/possible.
Replication	Project can be successfully replicated or expanded to other classes or schools.
Sustainability	Includes a plan to ensure the continuation of the project past the initial grant period where warranted.
Application Presentation	Application is complete as required with all sections filled out and includes all requested information: appropriate grammar, spelling and punctuation, clear synopsis, detailed budget, and necessary signatures and submitted by predetermined due date.
